Results from the 2020 Primary Health Survey and the 2021 Home Care Survey

Home care services support older adults to age at home and in their communities.

97% of Extra-Mural Program clients

98% of home support services clients

These services helped me stay at home.

But more can be done to support older New Brunswickers to age in place.

In 2020, an estimated **7,500 older persons** needed home care services, but did not receive the services they felt they needed. In addition, among clients who received home care services in 2021:
